Enrolment Fee: \$20 (READY SET DANCE \$30) enrolment fee is due no later than week 3 of term 1.

Term Fees : All term payments must be paid by week 5 see Prospectus for further details.

Weekly Fees: If paying weekly, payment must be paid on the day prior to student dancing, this will avoid payments getting behind.

Confirming ADE Students must not attend lessons if they are unwell and we encourage all students to carry their own sanitiser gel in their dance bags together with a labelled water bottle. All students must be dropped off 'kiss and drop protocols' at their correct dance class times and picked up at correct times. Teachers will meet students at the front of the building and return them to the front of the building. Please do not enter the buildings unless paying for fees at the front desk or ordering dance wear. The Uniting Church now requires us to use their QR code if entering their premises.

Parental Supervision: Teachers understand that in the first few weeks our younger students may need a parent in the room. If there is a need for parental supervision during class, please discuss with the ADE dance teacher prior to the lesson commencement. Students must be picked up on time, if there is a problem, please advise our reception team or email &/or telephone Colette so supervision can be organized. All students are required to have their names marked off at the front desk prior to the commencement of their dance classes and rehearsals.

Saturday Classes start this Saturday the 6th of February. Classical Ballet Students wishing to participate in the ADV (Australian Dance Vision) Exams will need to attend a weekly class and a Saturday class. Please email Colette if your child is interested in participating in the exam process.

Jazz Exam Students start tomorrow Wednesday 3rd of February. See ADE Prospectus for specific times.

New England Dance Eisteddfod: Any students wishing to participate in a solo, duo or trio please email Colette this week so private lessons can be scheduled. Private lessons will only be available in Armidale on a Saturday.

Dance Orders: Ballet uniforms are compulsory for all levels and hair is to be pulled back into a bun, we do have a Jazz uniform or your child may wear purple and black. Please see the ladies at the front desk for all uniform and shoe enquires.

Classes will be a bit mixed up this week due to teachers taking time to put students in their correct classes, next week classes should be all running as normal.
